

City Council Meeting

April 2, 2015

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jim Sargent, Jeff Hayes, David Rice, and Ronnie Roper. Absent: James Schmitz.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Billy and Terri Hewitt were present to address a large water bill that was a result of a leak when snow was on the ground. The council discussed a percentage of the bill for the actual cost of producing water. The Franklin/Sebastian Water Authority audit was presented to the council for review. There was no further comments or discussion.

Peggy Metcalf, who lives on Rattlesnake Canyon Road, was present to discuss the drainage of the ditch in front of her house. She showed pictures and talked with the mayor and council about a resolution. The mayor assured her that when the ditch was dry (maybe summer) the city will work on it.
